### Entry Visas

On visa, please contact nearest Indonesian embassy/consulate in your country. The invitation letter you received from the Cambodian Minister for Environment should be sufficient for obtaining your entry visa to Indonesia. Please check about visas as soon as possible.

### Transportation:

- Participants can reach Palembang via international flights including Silk Air from Singapore and Airasia or transit in Sukarno-Hatta International Airport in Jakarta and connect with domestic flights (frequent).
- Airport Tax Jakarta: Rp 150,000 (international) and Rp 40,000 (domestic). Airport Tax Palembang: Rp 150,000 (international) and Rp 35,000 (domestic)
- The hotel is about 15 Km from the airport. The Hotel provides pick up services for all participants with prior notice of their flight schedules to the committee. In case you miss the pick-up you can take a Taxi, please ask from the official counter inside the terminal building. Normal fee from airport to hotel is Rp 50,000.

**Meeting Venue:**

MoP6 will be at the Aryaduta Hotel conference hall as well as several small meeting rooms.

**The Field Trip:**

The field trip will be a one full day - start early morning by bus and continue on boat to the new EAAF Network Site- Sembilang national Park, about 100 km north of Palembang city.

Participants may prepare comfortable shoes/sandals, hats, umbrella/light rain coat, sunglasses, and sun block skin protection, personal medicines and other needs for the field trip.

**About Sembilang National Park** The national park with the area of 202,896.31 hectares is located at Sungsang Sub District, Banyuasin District, South Sumatra Province on Sumatra Island. The park is one of the most important sites along the East Asian – Australasian Flyway.



Sembilang National Park has the largest and best remaining mangrove habitat in the east coast of Sumatra, as well as vast tidal flat which is harbors huge number of both resident and migratory waterbirds. It has one of the globally most complex shorebirds community, where about 100,000 migratory waterbirds have been observed use this site to feed and rest. The most common migratory shorebirds includes Terek Sandpiper, Common Redshank, Black-tailed Godwit and Bar-tailed Godwit.

The National Park regularly support >1% of the following global population (both resident waterbirds and

migratory shorebirds), such Asian Dowitcher *Limnodromus semipalmatus*, Spotted Greenshank *Tringa guttifer*, Far Eastern Curlew *Numenius madagascariensis*, Milky Stork *Mycteria cinerea*, Lesser Adjutant *Leptoptilos javanicus*.

### ***Weather***

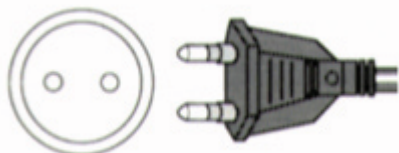
March is still in rainy season, with daily temperature of maximum 30°C and minimum 24°C .

### ***Currency***

Indonesian currency is RUPIAH (Rp/IDR). There are bank notes of 1,000, 5,000, 10,000, 20,000, 50,000 and 100,000 Rupiah. The exchange rate of Indonesian Rupiah is about Rp 11,760 per EURO or Rp 8,960 per USD (26 January 2012). You can change your bank notes currency in almost every Bank or Money Changer. ATMs with international access are available.

### ***Electricity***

Indonesia uses 220 Volt for its electricity, with an outlet type two round pins. If your appliance plug has a different shape, please bring a plug adapter.
