- Background: From discussions at previous national and international workshops for EAAF Flyway Network Site manager, it was recognized that there needs to be better communication between the site managers, EAAFP Partners and the Secretariat so as to better understand the work of each other. For the first time at a EAAFP Meeting of Partners, there will be some 30 FNS managers attending MoP10 from across the flyway. This includes more than 20 site managers from ASEAN countries who have been generously sponsored by the ASEAN Flyway Network project.
