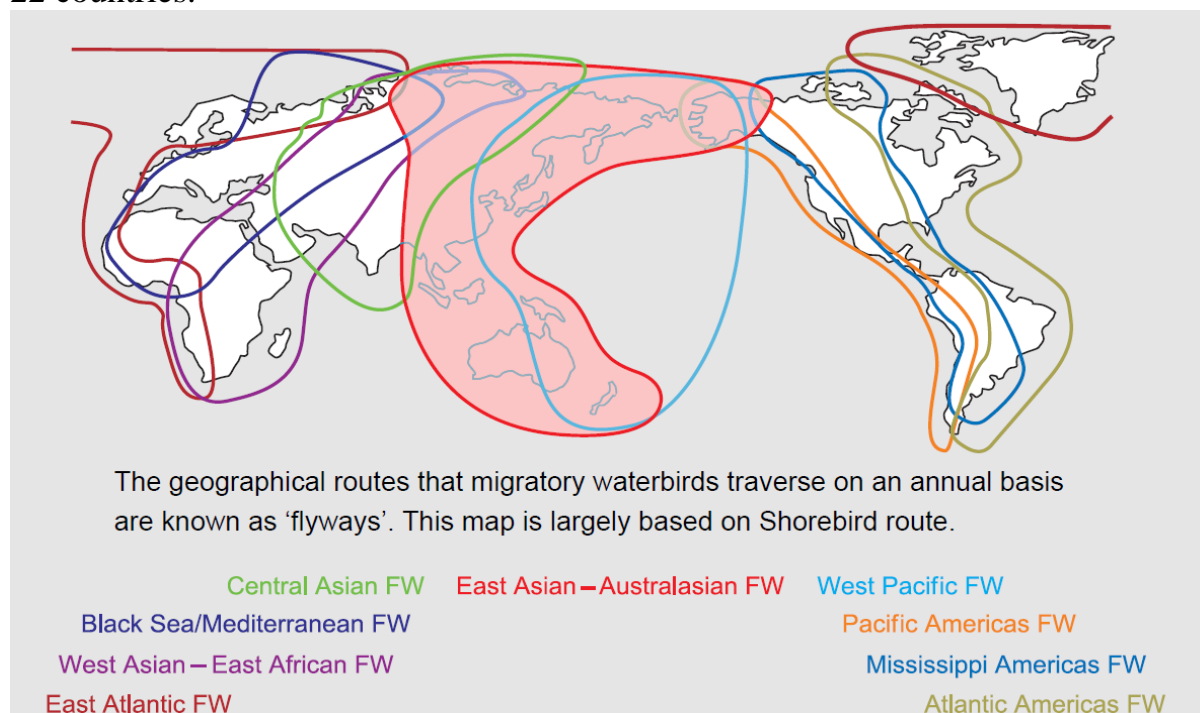

3. SHORT SUMMARY REPORT

On 20th of June 2016, Biodiversity Conservation Agency in cooperation with the Management Board of XuanThuy National Park (XTNP) organized a seminar themed Nomination of XuanThuy National Park as a Flyway site as well as conservation of water migratory birds.

The targets participants of the seminar were mainly the leader of XTNP, the officials of the park who take the responsibility for monitoring and conservation of migratory birds in XuanThuy as day-by-day assignment. Besides, the participants were also the experts in conservation and officials of Biodiversity Conservation Agency.

In the seminar, all of the participants actively discussed on:

- The status of migratory birds in XTNP. The challenges in bird conservation XTNP faces now;
- How to effectively manage and preserve migratory birds in XuanThuy;
- The opportunities and advantages when XTNP becomes a Flyway site;
- How to take advantage of participating in an international partnership as EAAFP...
