- CEPA Communication, Education, Participation, and Awareness
- At MOP10 EAAFP Strategic Plan 2019-2028 was adopted, and prioritized in Objective 2 to "Enhance communication, education, participation and awareness (CEPA) of the values of migratory waterbirds and their habitats".
- CEPA crosscuts all activities of the EAAFP
- Bridge the people of the flyway through coordinated CEPA
- Inspire conservation action as a result of CEPA





Accomplishments since MOP 10


- Reactivated CEPA WG in Aug 2021 after a hiatus
- Revised the Terms of Reference for Membership
- Proposed an update of the CEPA Action Plan (DD1)
- Proposed Youth Mainstreaming in EAAFP (DD10)
- Grown WG membership to 15
- Met monthly for the last 18 months
- Added youth representatives
- Reviewed and supported CEPA projects for Small Grants
- Supported WMBD, Youth Think Tank, and Sister Site Guidelines
