At present the concern for the preservation of bird migration sites is waters that have been polluted with microplastics, based on the results of research conducted by ESN on the Aceh/Krueng Aceh River, Banda Aceh City, which is a large river that divides the city of Banda Aceh and empties into the sea, there are 150 particles microplastics in 100 liters of river water, the danger threshold for exposure to microplastics in water is 20 mg per liter. These microplastics come from various kinds of inorganic waste such as household waste, this waste also causes contamination of the feeding and resting areas of migratory birds. The impact of microplastics on biota by the entry of these particles into the body of organisms can damage the digestive tract, inhibit growth and others.

This year we commemorate World Migratory Bird Day 2023 with the theme "Protect Water for the Future of Migratory Birds and Humans". Some of the activities that will be carried out are:

1. Campaign regarding the dangers of microplastics in water for ecosystems and humans"

This is done by educating the public about the dangers of microplastics in waters for ecosystems and humans, and ways to process waste properly and also calling on people not to litter. The main target of this activity is the community, and students.

2. Susur River/Beach in the Lampulo area, Banda Aceh

Susur River/Beach in the Lampulo area, Banda Aceh, this location was chosen because it was monitored as a shorebird migration site and it was also densely populated, This activity was held to invite the community directly to go into the field in cleaning the riverbanks and beaches from scattered trash, besides that several trash bins will also be placed at several points in the river/beach area that is busy being visited by the community.

3. Short Video Competition

The short video competition that was held aims to invite all people to care more about plastic waste and the dangers of microplastics to life through interesting

videos. The theme raised was "**Keeping water from plastic waste**", the target of the contest participants was the general public.

4. Photography competition with the theme "Save Water for the Future of Migratory Birds and Humans"

The photography competition held aims to invite all people to care more and work together in protecting water for the future of migratory birds and humans through beautiful works of art.

5. Essay writing competition

Essay writing competition with the theme "Utilization of Technology for Monitoring Waste and Microplastics" aims to improve students' critical thinking skills and generate innovative ideas and creativity, the target of the contest participants was the general public.

Expected results

- 1. Educate public to care about the dangers of microplastics to life
- 2. Fostering a sense of responsibility and a sense of love for the environment from an early age
- 3. Triggering more activities aimed at preserving nature, especially in protecting water from plastic waste pollution
- 4. Establish a relationship between the community and stakeholders.
