Title of event:	Celebrating World Migratory Bird Day with the Animal Farmers Society
Date of event:	08-15 October 2023

The celebration of World Migratory Bird Day 2023 in October will be held in Pasie Lubuk Village, Ingin Jaya District, Aceh Besar District, Aceh Province. The choice of location for the celebration is based on several factors, including the majority of the village community who work as farm workers, farmers and fishermen, so that their daily activities often always interact with groups of water birds and migratory birds.

The purpose of this celebration is that it is hoped that the community will be able to get to know the types of water birds and migratory birds that have existed in the village environment so far. Apart from that, the involvement of students from the Ajee Rayeuk State Elementary School (SDN) is due to the fact that the school is located in a transit habitat for various types of migratory birds which not many people even know about. In addition, this celebration is expected to integrate animal husbandry with conservation.

Animal farming can play an important role in efforts to conserve nature and biodiversity. While there may sometimes be conflict between livestock and conservation needs, there are ways in which animal agriculture can contribute to conservation goals, such as Livestock conducted under a sustainable agricultural approach can help minimize negative impacts on the environment. This includes practices such as good waste management, efficient use of natural resources and promoting animal welfare.

Livestock can be a source of income for local people, which in turn can reduce pressure on natural ecosystems. By providing sustainable economic alternatives, society may become less dependent on the exploitation of natural resources to the detriment of the environment.

However, keep in mind that the role of farms in conservation is very much dependent on how they are operated. Unsustainable livestock practices, such as chemical overuse, deforestation, and inefficient land use, can be detrimental to conservation efforts and the environment as a whole. Therefore, it is important to encourage and support eco-friendly and sustainable animal husbandry practices.

The 2023 World Migratory Bird Day (WMBD) celebration with the theme Water: Sustaining Bird Life will be carried out with several activities, including:

1. Public awareness activity

The proposer will coordinate with the village head to carry out "Livestock and Conservation" activities. Where this activity will be in the form of training for the community, to introduce bird species, the role of birds for the environment and

introduce tools/materials that have been used by the community but are harmful to birds.

As some breeders and farmers still use nets to mark boundaries, these nets are very dangerous for migratory birds and even other birds. Apart from that, some fishermen still use electric shocks when looking for fish, and there are still fishermen who consume various types of birds for lunch.

Through the celebration of World Migratory Bird Day, we will encourage people to slowly but surely abandon some activities that are harmful to migratory birds and water birds.

## 2. Festival

We will equip the community with posters of migratory birds and water birds in their environment, distribute bird-themed clothes, and put up banners/stickers at their places of business stating that they are caring breeders and environmental stewards.

Lastly, we will try to get several species of birds caught from the community to be released back into the wild.

### Expected Result:

1. Animal husbandry in Gampong Pasie Lubuk has abandoned the use of nets.
2. Fishermen are familiar with various types of migratory birds/water birds and will switch to a healthier diet.
3. School children know the birds in their environment.
4. Farmers know the role of birds that have a positive impact on land/rice fields, so they will preserve them.
